Juried Student Art Show
Rules & Important Information

This juried art show is open to students in grades 6-12. Home educated students are also welcome to enter. It is highly recommended that you read these instructions fully before you enter a work or works in this art show.

I. Categories: painting: oil, acrylic, or watercolor

II. Drawing: pencil, charcoal, pen and ink, colored pencil, or pastels

III. Mixed media: combinations of media. May be hanging or free-standing.

IV. 3-D Sculpture: assemblages, hand-built ceramics, clay, or plaster.

V. Elementary artist corner: Art teachers are asked to submit one (1) elementary student piece (from each category above) that they feel shows exceptional merit. (NO ENTRY FEE). Elementary artwork will be on display for the entire exhibition and MAY NOT BE SOLD. Please label and prepare elementary artwork in accordance with the following standards:

RULES:

1. All work must arrive ready for immediate display. All required frames, mounting, hardware, or stands must be included. The Bedford Arts Cooperative is NOT responsible for preparing works to be displayed.

2. All work must be clearly labeled as follows:

3. To encourage works to be submitted in their best possible form, the Bedford Arts Cooperative will offer weekly workshop hours staffed by a professional artist, Ms. Linda Callaway. ***All work must be the sole enterprise of the student.**

**Tuesdays, from 3:30-5:30, beginning March 3rd and running through
Tuesday, March 31st.**

4. **DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING ARTWORK:**

Artwork may be dropped off in “ready to display” format on:

Sunday, April 5th from 1:00-3:00pm and Monday, April 6th from 3:00-5:00pm.

5. The entry fee of \$10.00 per initial entry and \$5.00 each additional entry must be paid at the time of drop off. Cash, check, or money order will be accepted. Credit cards may be used for payment for a nominal additional fee of \$1.50. If, for any reason, the BAC decides to NOT display your work, your fee/s will be refunded in full.
6. As we want this art show to be a positive learning experience for students, we will not collect our customary commission on any sale of artwork during the run of the show. Artists will keep 100% of their proceeds.
7. The official opening, artists' reception, and awards will take place on:
Saturday, April 25th from 5:00pm-6:30pm.
Ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners
with 1 "Best in Show" winner.
8. The BAC reserves the right to photograph the artists and their works and to include these photographs in press releases and online on BAC social media pages, websites, and those of their affiliates.
9. The "Juried Student Art Show" will run from Saturday, April 25th through Sunday, May 31st.
10. PICK UP DATES: **Saturday, June 6th from 1-3pm & Sunday, June 7th from 1-3pm.**
All artwork must be retrieved at this time. Any piece that is not collected will become property of BAC and may be sold or disposed of.
